

Dr. Bosworth remembered

NASSAWADOX – The Board of Trustees of Shore Health Services, Inc. has unanimously adopted a resolution of remembrance, respect and gratitude for the late Dr. Elam W. Bosworth II.

The resolution was presented to the Board by Chairman Caramine Kellam in March in recognition of Dr. Bosworth’s “outstanding service and exemplary dedication of duty to his patients and his community”, according to the resolution. He “displayed dignity, exhibited integrity and maintained a devotion to duty well-befitting his position, earning him the esteem and respect of his colleagues, associates, employees, patients, and the citizens of his community.”

Mrs. Stella Bosworth, widow of Dr. Bosworth, and their son, Mr. Chris Bosworth, were presented with a copy of the resolution.

Dr. Bosworth practiced medicine on the Eastern Shore of Virginia from 1963 until his retirement in 2002. Before moving to the Eastern Shore, Dr. Bosworth practiced for 10 years in Lexington and Farmville, Virginia.
